

#### Overview of products and activities - QVG, Germany

QVG as a adult education institution conducted the activities in the field of in-service trainings for trainers, teachers working with adults and activities with adult learners (unemployed women). In order to increase impact of the project and its results, QVG invited adult education centre VHS Cham (Volkshochschule im Landkreis Cham e.V.) to the common cooperation in the project.

# 1. In – service trainings for trainers, teachers working in adult education sector – how to teach with Moodle adult learners

Trainers and teachers had an opportunity to take part in the project "Freelearning" managed by Bavarian Association for Adult Education – BVV.

Freelearning is a eLearning Project supported by the Bavarian Ministry of Culture and Education and financed by the Bavarian Culture Fund (January 2005 – June 2008)

#### **Activities:**

Further education of the counsellors: under Nürnberg-EDV/ Beruf Bavarian Freelearning Fairs: under bvv-München

### Project results:

On the regional level

- Selection of a LMS (learning management system) = Moodle (over 330,000 registered users speaking over 70 languages in 196 countries.
- Selection of professional contents (language, ICT, soft skills, vocational skills)
- Online tutor qualification (over 200 hours) for 50 tutors cost-free, financed by the project.
- Concept and realisation of the qualification by Kanter Media www.KanterMedia.de•
- Further training of BVV and VHS trainer to work and teach with Moodle.



#### On the institutional level:

- Raising awareness of teachers, trainers about using ICT including Moodle in adult education.
- Raising knowledge about using Moodle, how to introduce new ICT instruments e.g. in vocational information and counselling for adults
- Raising awareness about various possibilities of using Moodle in learning, not only specific professional competences, but also culture, entertainment.





## 2. Introduction of ICT course for adult learners

Within the project Adult and ICT pilot workshop how to design and establish website was organised. Within the group of unemployed women, volunteers took part in the pilot. The pilot included:

- introduction of project activities
- introduction of ICT tools e.g BLOOM



- introduction of ICT tools in order to design the website
- introduction and training on the use of Moodle platform
- workshop on designing project website participants' tasks were: inserting text, pictures, working with pdf etc, making a structute of the website

# Results of the activities:

- Raising knowledge of using ICT tools among adult learners
- Improving self esteem and soft skills (ICT workshops were integrated with introduction of social skills and working in the group)
